

Vista Fleet Marine Technician

Specializes in repairing and maintaining all marine vessels owned by the Vista Fleet (Vista Star and Vista Queen). Among their responsibilities include addressing the clients' issues and concerns, troubleshooting problems, inspecting and fixing electrical and mechanical equipment, installing new systems, and assessing existing ones to identify areas needing improvement, conducting upgrades as required. Furthermore, as a marine technician, it is essential to maintain an active communication line with team members while adhering to the safety policies and regulations.

Responsibilities

- Operate wide variety of equipment including power saws, grinders, cranes drill press and basic hand tools.
- Perform all necessary repairs to hulls, electrical systems, as well as engines.
- Perform maintenance, diagnostics, and repairs on all marine vessels owned by Vista Fleet..
- Troubleshoot and repair when able electrical and plumbing systems aboard vessels.
- Rig load demand, steering and trim systems.
- Use of ladders and not be afraid of heights or water.
- Operate the latest diagnostic software to troubleshoot and repair.
- Repair and maintenance of shipboard systems including HVAC and refrigeration.
- Perform maintenance, diagnostics, and repairs of vessels.
- Maintain, diagnose and repair all systems aboard the Vista Star and Vista Queen.
- Experience in weatherization preparation of boats for winter storage.
- Lead, communicate and perform with the USCG annual and five year inspections.
- Implement and execute proactive preventative maintenance inclusive of filter checks, oil changes, shaft packings, etc..
- Thorough knowledge and understanding of operation and safety procedures including, but not limited to, general boat operation, emergency preparedness, and fire containment. Know boat systems, electrical, plumbing, mechanical, etc.
- Follow security policies as directed by the US Coast Guard and Office of Homeland Security. Observe and report any breaches in Homeland Security to the General Manager (CSO).
- Complete all tasks described on the relevant cruise check list in a thorough and timely manner.
- Responsible for upholding Vista Fleet standards.
- Resolve any problems with customers or employees in a professional manner maintaining Vista Fleet standards.
- Maintain a clean work area, uniform and person.
- Perform all tasks as directed by the Management Personnel, Owners, or Governing Bodies.
- Keep confidential the business functions of the company including, but not limited to, financial status, passenger information, and employee issues.
- Treat all people in a positive manner with dignity and respect.
- Carry out all duties in a safe manner.
- Properly handle all accidents and medical emergencies as policy dictates with safety as the first concern.
- Take responsibility for overall appearance and operation of the vessels. Report any short comings to management.

Necessary Skills

- Background in maintenance of marine vessels or similar large operating vehicles.
- Must be able to communicate professionally with passengers and crew.
- Proof of Valid TWIC Card
- Employee must be honest and able to work with little supervision.

Physical Requirements

- Must be at least 21 years of age.
- Must be sure-footed and able to stand/walk on feet for 10 hours or more – not to exceed a 12 hour shift in a 24 hour period.
- Must be able to speak, when appropriate, at loud volume in a clear, understandable voice; hear at a basic level; and communicate in English.
- Must have eyesight enabling vision both near and far.
- Must have ability to write clearly.
- Must be able to bend and move in close quarters, stretch arms overhead, climb stairs, and lift and/or carry up to 30 pounds, and lift engine room hatch.
